TASHKENT

- **Kukeldash Madrasah** – is a medieval madrasa in Tashkent, located close to Chorsu Bazaar and Chorsu Metro station. It was built around 1570 by the Shaybanid ruler Dervish Sultan.
- **Hast-Imam Mosque** – is the largest mosque in the city, it was an expensive undertaking and the interior of the blue-tiled domes is decorated with genuine gold leaf. The most important is undoubtedly the Muvi Muborak Library holds the world's oldest Qu'ran.

SAMARKAND

- **Mausoleum Guri Emir** – is the tomb of Tamerlane and later became the tomb of the Timur family. The mausoleum is has strong oriental Islamic architectural features and is a world-renowned Central Asian architectural treasure.
- **Registan Square** – The Registan, which literally means 'a sandy place'. The complex consists of three seminaries: Tilla-Kari Madrasah, which is also the main mosque, where prayers are held on Fridays and on holidays. On the left is the Ulugh Beg Theological Seminary (Ulugh Beg is a scholar, astronomer, poet and philosopher in the Middle Ages); Seminary; on the right is Sher-Doll (meaning Tibetan Tiger) Seminary.
- **Shah-I-Zinda Complex** – The complex is a huge burial place for noblemen of the Timurids' times. It consists of beautiful mausoleums with blue sky-like domes, mosques with painted majolica. The mausoleums was named after the cousin of the Prophet Muhammad, Kusam ibn Abbas, who was called Shakh Zinda, which translates as "The Living King" from Persian. The legend says that Kusam ibn Abbas arrived in Samarkand for preaching of Islam, but he was killed by an arrow in one of the unbelievers' attacks.
- **Ulughbek Observatory** – is an observatory in modern day Samarkand, Uzbekistan, which was built in the 1420s by the Timurid astronomer Ulugh Beg. This school of astronomy was constructed under the Timurid Empire and was the last of its kind from the Islamic Medieval period.

BISHKEK

- **The Manas Sculptural Complex** – The Manas Sculptural Complex, completed in 1981, is located in Manas Square. The main statue depicts a legendary hero on a magical horse who slays an evil dragon. Under this statue are other statues of the hero's wife and a wise man. This beautiful square is paved in red granite.
- **Burana Tower** – ancient Arabic language, Burana translates as « minaret ». This impressive ancient minaret, made of red bricks, built between the 10th and 11th centuries, the Burana tower with its 45 m (148 ft) height overlooked the ancient city of Balasagun, constructed by the Karakhanids in the 9th century. Today, the Burana minaret has become an open-air historical and architectural complex, one of Kyrgyzstan's most outstanding historical sites.

LAKE ISSYK KUL

- **Lake Issyk Kul** – is an endorheic lake in the northern Tian Shan mountains in eastern Kyrgyzstan. It is the seventh-deepest lake in the world, the tenth-largest lake in the and the third-largest saline lake. Issyk-Kul means "warm lake" in the Kyrgyz language; although it is located at a lofty elevation of 1,607 metres (5,272 ft) and subject to severe cold during winter, it rarely freezes, due to the salinity.
- **Open-Air Museum of Petroglyphs** – lay at the north-west of the city. This open-air museum, sometimes nicknamed "the stone garden", is a very important historical site. It is on 42 ha (104 acres) that includes petroglyphs, images carved on stones, and prehistoric structures and monuments.

ALMATY

- **Shymbulak Ski Resort** – It is located just 25 km from the center of Almaty. Reachable via a cable car that starts from Medeu, the resort sits at an elevation of 2,200 meters.
- **High Mountain Sports Complex Medeu** – is an outdoor speed skating and bandy rink on the outskirts of Almaty, about 1,691 meters above sea level. It was built in 1949, it spans 10.5 hectares and can host up to 30,000 visitors. Medeu Skating Rink known as the highest skating rink in the world.
- **Huns Ethno Village** – is an immersive cultural experience, It is designed to transport visitors back to the era of the ancient Hun civilization that once roamed the steppes of Kazakhstan. The village features reconstructed traditional dwellings, including yurts and wooden homes, furnished with artifacts and tools that offer a glimpse into the daily lives of the Huns. The family that operates the village were all donning period-appropriate attire for that added touch of authenticity. During visit, offer a variety of activities such as archery, horseback riding, and traditional crafts. You may see a demonstrations on cooking traditional Kazakh foods, Boursaks Kazakh Puffy Bread and sampled freshly made kumis (fermented mare milk). Traditional music, shown the inside of a yurt, and a horse show with several cultural games on display. It's a living, breathing reenactment of history set against the natural beauty of the surrounding landscape. Come and experience Kazakhstan's famous hospitality in a beautiful mountain setting.
- **Zenkov Cathedral** – officially known as the Ascension Cathedral, is a feat of wooden architecture situated in the heart of Panfilov Park. It is built entirely without nails and is considered one of the tallest wooden buildings in the world. This Russian Orthodox cathedral showcases an impressive mastery of craftsmanship.
