SHOPPING

IZMIR

- **Kemeralti Bazaar** - is one of the world's oldest bazaars. The 2,400-year-old Kemeralti Bazaar of Izmir, which embraces many historical places, has been the city's shopping mall since the Hellenistic period. Here you can find handmade products, traditional Turkish carpets, jewelry, leather goods, textile products, spices, local foods, and much more at an affordable price. There are also antique shops, coffee houses, and restaurants within the market.

SELÇUK

- **Şirince Village** - Picturesque village near Selçuk known for its historic architecture, vineyards, and olive groves. Famous for its quaint streets, traditional houses, and locally produced wines and crafts. A popular destination for tourists seeking a tranquil escape and authentic rural Turkish experience.

PRIENE

- **Ancient Ruins of Priene** - It represent a well-preserved example of a Hellenistic city. Known for its planned grid layout designed by the famous architect Hippodamus, Priene offers insights into ancient Greek urban planning. Key attractions include the Temple of Athena, the Bouleuterion (Council House), and the Theater, showcasing the city's cultural and architectural achievements.

BODRUM

- **Castle of St. Peter** - Built by the Knights Hospitaller in the 15th century. Known for its impressive medieval architecture and historical significance as a fortress and museum.

MARMARIS

- **Marmaris Castle** - Served various purposes throughout history, including as a military stronghold and a residence for Ottoman sultans. Today, it houses the Marmaris Museum, offering insights into the region's history and culture.

DALYAN

- **Kaunos Ancient City** - The ancient city of Kaunos passed under the rule of Persia, Egypt, Rhodes, Pergamon kingdom, and the Roman empire over time. Kaunos, which was a commercially important port city in Antiquity, lost its port feature over time as the sea was filled with alluvium.

FETHIYE

- **Ölüdeniz Blue Lagoon** - Known for its stunning Blue Lagoon and turquoise waters. It's famous for swimming, snorkeling, and paragliding, offering a mix of natural beauty and outdoor activities in a relaxed coastal setting.

- **Kayaköy** - Is an abandoned village near Fethiye, Turkey. It was once home to Greek Orthodox Christians and Muslims. After being abandoned following the Greco-Turkish War and population exchange in the early 20th century, it now stands as a poignant reminder of its rich cultural history.

KAŞ

The beach is formed by a gorge that opens out into a stretch of sand and is accessible via a dramatic staircase carved into the surrounding rock formations.
- **Old Town Kas** - One of the cutest destinations on the Turquoise Coast, Old Town Kas is a charming cluster of pedestrian streets that will remind visitors of the Greek islands. Colorful facades line the cobble lanes, home to funky boutiques, lovely cafes, al fresco dining and carpet shops.

DEMRE

- **Church Of St. Nicholas** - The church houses the tomb of Saint Nicholas, a revered figure in Christianity known for his acts of generosity and kindness. The site attracts pilgrims and tourists alike who come to pay their respects and explore the rich history and cultural heritage associated with Saint Nicholas.
- **Ancient City of Myra** - It is an archaeological site renowned for its well-preserved Lycian rock-cut tombs and ancient theater. It flourished as a prominent city in the Lycian League during the Hellenistic and Roman periods. Myra is particularly famous for its impressive theater, which is carved into the hillside and offers stunning views of the surrounding landscape. The site also includes numerous sarcophagi and an impressive Roman-era bath complex, providing a glimpse into the city's rich history and cultural heritage.

ANTALYA

- **Ancient City Side** - It was an important port city in antiquity. It flourished during the Greek, Roman, and Byzantine periods and is known for its well-preserved ruins, including a theater, temples, and city walls. Side's picturesque setting on a peninsula surrounded by sandy beaches adds to its allure as a popular tourist destination.
